Racine's is one of Denver's oldest standbys for food and fun. The space offers hip, modern décor. The large room boasts a bright interior, center bar and roominess between the tables for comfortable dining. Bright colors, vibrant paintings, and great lighting add to the scene. The menu is full of choices. Start with guacamole, a creamy artichoke dip, nachos or smoked salmon. Salads include a great salmon salad, ahi niçoise, cobb, and nutty cheese with greens. Pastas range from chicken Gorgonzola to lasagna, ziti, and shrimp scampi. If sandwiches are your choice, go for the club, French dip, Reuben or one of the burgers. The turkey is roasted daily for the sandwiches and the taste is terrific. Did you say you want Mexican? Tortilla wraps, enchiladas, rellenos, burritos, and fajitas will fill the bill. Don't miss the fish and chips, steaks, coconut shrimp, and salmon entrées. None should leave without a dessert such as brownies, ice cream pies, fruit cobblers, and more to end the meal.
